Family: Adoxaceae Common Name: Elderberry

- Height: 5-12'
- Spread: 5-12'
- Light requirements: Full sun to part shade
- Soil: moist, humusy, well-drained, slightly acid
- Flower color: White
- Fruit: Edible purple-black berries with crimson juice
- Growth: Deciduous shrub
- Native Origin: Midwest United States
- Interesting Fact: "Fruit may be used to make preserves, jellies, pies and wine"
