
Easy steps to make a reusable tote bag from your old fabrics. Use as a guide and adjust depending on the size of your fabric. Looking forward to seeing your creativity!

Making a Reusable Tote Bag




Step 2 – Fold, Iron & Sew Straps



Step 1 – Cut Fabric for Bag and Straps


Step 3 – Straps and Logo

- a) Optional Finish Raw Edges at A & B
- b) Pin or stitch straps to bag. Watch for twists in straps
- c) Sew logo 5" from raw edge and centered between straps




Step 4 – Stitch side seams

- a) Fold fabric in half with right sides together
- b) Stich with a ¼" seam
- c) Optional Finish raw edges of side seams




Step 6 – Box corners

- a) Optional turn bag right side out and press side seams and press seam at bottom
- b) Lay side seam along center fold of bottom of bag
- c) Stitch across it at 3.5" in from corner



Step 5 – Finish top edge of bag & attach straps

- a) Fold down top edge of bag to create 1" hem
- b) Stitch twice around the top and bottom edges
- c) Optional Reinforce straps with more stitches



Step 7 – Finished Reusable Tote Bag

- a) Turn the bag right side out
- b) Quality control
- c) Reusable Tote Bag!!
